R H Coutier Champagne NV \$36 _____

Ambonnay is famous for wines of great finesse, supple fruit, and length. Coutier has been called the —King of Ambonnay|| by Richard Juhlin, author of *4000 Champagnes*. For a true lover of Champagne.

Dumol Viognier Lia 2007 \$49 2 bottles _____

One of the best efforts DuMOL has made yet with their white Rhone program is the 2007 Viognier Lia. This goes through full malolactic yet is bone dry and retains tremendously crisp acidity, giving uplift to the very substantial lychee, apricot, peach, and exotic fruit notes of this full-bodied, fresh, lively wine, which even has some minerality, something that the top Condrieus from the northern Rhone also possess. This wine should drink nicely for several years. **The Wine Advocate 91 pts**

Felsina Chianti Classico Rancia 2005 \$35 1 bottle _____

The 2005 Chianti Classico Riserva Rancia is a beautifully fresh, perfumed version of this wine. It reveals a lovely core of ripe red fruit intermingled with sweet toasted oak and a winsome, attractive personality. **The Wine Advocate 92 pts**

Domaine Serene Pinot Noir Jerusalem Hill 2005 \$59 5 bottles _____

Silky, refined and unexpectedly generous on the finish, this sashays over the palate with lots in reserve. Starts with pretty currant and blackberry fruit, then deepens with hints of cream, slate and chalk notes, all the while retaining a sense of sweetness and elegance. Drink now through 2015. 400 cases made- **Wine Spectator 94 pts**

Ken Wright Pinot Noir Guadalupe 2007 \$58 _____

Brooding cherry skin and dark berry aromas are complemented by hints of fresh blood and dried flowers. Juicy dark berry flavors are framed by supple tannins and provide very good palate coverage. Becomes sweeter on the finish, with the cherry and dark berry notes echoing. **Stephen Tanzer 90 pts**

Ken Wright Pinot Noir Canary Hill 2007 \$58 _____

Deep red. Smoky raspberry and cherry-cola aromas are complemented by dusty spices and herbs. Fleshy red and dark berry flavors boast very good concentration and good nervy cut. Offers a suave blend of depth and energy, with excellent finishing clarity and lingering sweetness. **Stephen Tanzer 91 pts**

Ken Wright Pinot Noir Savoya 2007 \$58 _____

Bright red. Expressive aromas of red berries, cherry and oak spice. Medium-bodied and tightly focused, with good energy and clarity to the red fruit flavors. Finishes with very good mineral snap and a strong echo of red berries. **Stephen Tanzer 90 pts**

Elvio Cogno Barolo Ravera 2003 \$39 2 bottles _____

In 2003 the heat filled out the wine's frame nicely, giving it an attractive plumpness and soft, accessible personality. Today it is primary, with just the barest hints of macerated cherries and spices coming through, but it should be superb in another few years once the full range of aromatics have developed in the bottle. This gorgeous, poised Barolo should drink well to age 15, perhaps beyond. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2018. **The Wine Advocate 92 pts**

Plumpjack Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 \$79 3 bottles _____

A beautiful inky color is followed by concentrated crème de cassis fruit intermixed with graphite, and spicy new oak notes. This medium to full-bodied, structured, muscular Cabernet needs 2 years of cellaring, and should drink well for two decades. **The Wine Advocate 91**

Plumpjack Syrah 2006 \$47 9 bottles _____

Plumpjack's Syrah is a blend of fruit from the Hudson Vineyard in Carneros and the Stagecoach Vineyard just above the Silverado Trail. It reveals a Northern Rhone-like character with its smoky, gamy, lard, roasted meat, bouquet garni, and blackberry-scented bouquet. Full-bodied, stylish, and loaded with complexity, it should drink well for a decade. **The Wine Advocate 92 pts**

Plumpjack Chardonnay Reserve 2007 \$47 4 bottles _____

These are consistently brilliant wines thanks to the efforts of winemaker Tony Biagia. The 2007 offerings reflect what a great site this 40-acre vineyard planted in the tenderloin of Oakville truly is.

Cade Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 \$49 5 bottles _____

The new Plumpjack project, Cade, is a state of the art, 100% Solar powered wine making facility on Howell Mountain. The same winemaking team from Plumpjack heads this winery up. If you like **Dunn, Viader, Robert Foley, and Ladera**, then you will love this wine.

Patz & Hall Dutton Ranch Chardonnay 2007 \$39 11 bottles _____

Aromas of smoky, buttered hazelnuts, nectarines, and orange blossom emerge from the 2006 Chardonnay Dutton Ranch. With medium to full body, and good acidity as well as freshness, this Meursault-like white should drink nicely for 3-4 years. Score: 91. —Robert Parker, December 2008.

Bodegas El Nido 2006 \$95 3 bottles _____

"The 2006 El Nido is 70% Cabernet Sauvignon and 30% Monastrell aged for 26 months in new oak. Aromas of wild blueberry and black currant are room-filling. Dense, layered, and totally hedonistic, it has serious depth and concentration, impeccable balance, and a 60-second finish. A bit more structured than Clio, it will have a drinking window extending from 2013 to 2026." -Jay Miller Wine Advocate 97 Points

Marquis Phillips Grail of Lisa 2005 \$42 5 bottles _____

"In 2005 we made a reserve level wine that was neither Shiraz 9 nor Shiraz Integrity, but as good as both, if not better than both. The Grail of Lisa. A mind-blowing wine that takes MP to a new level and probably one of the top three wines we've ever made. Vibrant ripe blackberries, fruitcake with layers of cinnamon and toffee. Smooth vanillin palate, round luscious concentration of fruit with an oak spice finish." 92 points

Larmkead Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 \$43 5 bottles _____

Robert Parker 90 "The 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Estate (93% Cabernet Sauvignon and 7% Petit Verdot) exhibits a deep ruby/purple color, a sweet nose of floral-infused black currants and cherries, some smoke and graphite notes, outstanding density, ripeness, and overall harmony. Still backward and austere in the finish, this is a Medoc look-alike that should drink handsomely between 2010 and 2020+."

Gargiulo Money Road Cabernet 2005 \$59 9 bottles 851 cases produced _____

—If you like Silver Oak...you'll love this wine! We just sampled this thriller and 'WOW'!!! The flavors will be familiar because this vineyard has been a major component of PRIDE and SHAFER Cabernet for the last decade! Decadent layers of dark chocolate, melted licorice and bold tannins that we HIGHLY RECOMMEND. This is a weighty wine that finishes with the hallmark Silver Oak eucalyptus flavor. Decant for at least ½ hour if popping the cork pre-2011 because this BIG boy will easily last until 2019, peaking around 2014 in our estimate. Betts & Scholl OG Grenache 2006 \$21 3 bottles _____

WS 90pts. - According to the Wine Spectator: Velvety, round and remarkably transparent, with raspberry, cherry and dusky spice flavors competing for attention as the flavors sail through the long finish, framed with fine-grained tannins. Drink now through 2013. 900 cases made. Tasting Notes - Vivid red color. Energetic red and dark berry aromas expand with air, picking up fresh rose and incense qualities. Deeply concentrated raspberry and blackberry flavors are given spine by dusty minerality, turning firmer on the close. Fine-grained tannins guide the sweet fruit through a long, gently chewy finish.
